

How to Move your User Files from the TND to the Tablet

1. All the following will do is “Copy” the “User” folders from the TND to the Tablet. Because the Tablet has “Hidden” folders, you have to change the settings to be able to “View” the folders you will put your “User” files in.
2. On your Computer Desktop, create a folder called TND Files.
3. Connect your TND (turned on) to the Computer.
4. Open a “File Explore” Window.
5. Find the “Drive” letter associated with your TND.
6. Open up that “Drive” letter.
7. You should see the following folders.
 - a. Navi.
 - b. NaviMaps.
 - c. NaviVoices.
 - d. RM.
8. Copy the following folders from the TND to the desktop folder “TND Files.”
We are going to copy the entire two folders since the two subfolders we need are both called “User.”
 - a. Navi.
 - b. RM.
9. Disconnect the TND.
10. On the Tablet (Turned on).
 - a. Turn on “Show Hidden Files and Folders.”
 - i. Tablet Main Screen.
 - ii. Tap on the 9 dots in the upper right.
 - iii. Look for “File Manager.”
 - iv. Tap on “File Manager.”
 - v. Tap on the 3 dots in the lower right.
 - vi. Tap on “Settings.”
 - vii. Second Item from top, Tap on the box (right side) to “Show Hidden Files and Folders.
 - viii. Tap on “Home Button.”
11. Connect the Tablet to the Computer. Look on back of Tablet to determine model of Tablet in the serial number.
 - a. Set as USB Storage.

How to Move your User Files from the TND to the Tablet

- i. TNDT 70.
 1. Main Screen.
 2. Swipe down from the top left.
 3. You should see "USB Connected."
 4. Tap on "USB Connected."
 5. You should now see the Green Android Man.
 6. Bottom right tap on "Turn on USB Storage."
 7. Tap on "OK" if a small pop up window appears.
 - ii. "Original" TNDT 80.
 1. Main Screen.
 2. Swiped down from top left.
 3. You should see "USB Connected."
 4. Tap on "USB Connected."
 5. You should now see the Green Android Man.
 6. Bottom right tap on "Turn on USB Storage."
 7. Tap on "OK" if a small pop up window appears.
 - iii. TNDT 80B.
 1. Main Screen.
 2. Swipe down from the Middle.
 3. You should see "Connected as a Media Device."
 4. Tap on "Connected as a Media Device."
 5. Make sure the "Media Device (MTP) is checked.
12. Open up a "File Explorer" window on your computer.
 13. Find the "Drive Letter" associated with your Tablet and click on it.
 14. Minimize this "File Explorer" window so that it only shows on the right side of your computer screen.
 15. Find on your Desktop the folder called "TND Files" and open that up, minimize this "File Explorer" window so that is only shows on the left side of your computer screen.
 16. Now you should be looking at two "File Explorer" windows.
 - a. On the Left is the folder from your desktop called "TND Files."
 - b. On the right is the folder showing the Tablet.

How to Move your User Files from the TND to the Tablet

17. On the left window open up the “Navi” folder. You should see a “User” folder.
 - a. Open up the “Navi/User” folder.
 - i. You should see the following files/folders.
 1. Will Copy
 - a. AddressBook (Folder).
 - b. History (Folder).
 - c. Trip.db (File).
 2. Will not copy.
 - a. Cloud (Folder)
 - b. User.ini (File) – will not copy.
 - c. UserGPS.ini (File) – will not copy.
18. On the right window click on the following drives/folders “Internal Storage/.navi/User.” And then Double Click on the “User” folder.
19. You should see the same folders/files now on both the Left and Right File Explore Windows.
20. On the Left window, holding the “CTRL” key down, Left click on the following folders/files.
 - a. AddressBook (Folder).
 - b. History (Folder).
 - c. Trip.db (File).
21. This should highlight them.
22. Now “Left” click on the Right folder in an open area.
23. Right Click, then click on Paste.
24. Overwrite all files/folders.
25. On the “Left” File Explore window, in the “address” bar click back on the folder “TND.” You should see the Navi and RM folders again.
26. On the left window Double Click on the “RM” folder. You should see a “User” folder.
 - a. Open up the “RM/User” folder.
 - i. You should see the following files/folders.
 1. Will Copy
 - a. AvoidedSegment.db.

- b. Downloadedtrails.db.
 - c. Fuel.db
 - d. Maintenance.db
 - e. Memo.db
 - f. Mycustompoi.db
 - g. Trails.db
 - h. Truck.db.
- 2. Will not copy.
 - a. Sounds (Folder)
 - b. TruckCarlcons (Folder).
- 27. On the “Right” File Explore window, in the “address” bar click back on the folder “.navi”. You should see the Bin, Layouts, Logs, NaviMaps, NaviVoices, RM, and User folders again.
- 28. On the right window click on the “RM” folder. And then Double Click on the “User” folder.
- 29. You should see the same folders/files now on both the Left and Right File Explore Windows.
- 30. On the Left window, holding the “CTRL” key down, Left click on the following files.
 - a. AvoidedSegment.db.
 - b. Downloadedtrails.db.
 - c. Fuel.db
 - d. Maintenance.db
 - e. Memo.db
 - f. Mycustompoi.db
 - g. Trails.db
 - h. Truck.db.
- 31. This should highlight them.
- 32. Now “Left” click on the Right folder in an open area.
- 33. Right Click, then Paste, overwrite all files.
- 34. This should now have moved all your “User” files from the TND to the Tablet.

How to Move your User Files from the TND to the Tablet

35. Press the On/Off button momentarily to wake the Tablet up if the screen “blanked out.”

- a. On the TNDT 70 Tablet and the “Original” TNDT 80 Tablet.
 - i. Press the lower right “Turn off USB Storage.”
 - ii. Disconnect from the computer.
- b. On the TNDT 80B just disconnect it from the computer.
