Relief of Duty for Over the Road Drivers

To All Drivers;

Following FMCSA regulation 395.2 Cross Creek Trucking relieve their commercial drivers of duty and all responsibility for the care and custody of the commercial motor vehicle, its accessories and cargo during "off duty" time. The driver is at liberty to pursue activities of his/her own choosing and to leave the premises where the vehicle is situated.

In the event that a vehicle is being attended to by a mechanic, the driver is allowed to enter "off duty" status as long as the driver is not doing the repairs.

Cross Creek Trucking does not allow nor does it request drivers to load or unload freight. During these loading or unloading times, the drivers are given permission to go "off duty" or into "sleeper" for the duration of this time until they are informed by the customer that they are finished. At that time the driver is now on "on duty, not driving" to complete the loading process.
