

MD5 (CHECK SUM) PROCEDURES FOR TABLETS

1. Turn on "Show Hidden Files and Folders."
 - a. Tablet Main Screen.
 - i. Tap on the 9 dots in the upper right.
 - ii. Look for "File Manager."
 - iii. Tap on "File Manager."
 - iv. Tap on the 3 dots in the lower right.
 - v. Tap on "Settings."
 - vi. Second Item from top, Tap on the box (right side) to "Show Hidden Files and Folders."
2. Connect the Tablet to the Computer. Look on back of Tablet to determine model of Tablet in the serial number.
 - a. Set as USB Storage.
 - i. TNDT 70.
 1. Main Screen.
 2. Swipe down from the top left.
 3. You should see "USB Connected."
 4. Tap on "USB Connected."
 5. You should now see the Green Android Man.
 6. Bottom right tap on "Turn on USB Storage."
 7. Tap on "OK" if a small pop up window appears.
 - ii. "Original" TNDT 80.
 1. Main Screen.
 2. Swiped down from top left.
 3. You should see "USB Connected."
 4. Tap on "USB Connected."
 5. You should now see the Green Android Man.
 6. Bottom right tap on "Turn on USB Storage."
 7. Tap on "OK" if a small pop up window appears.
 - iii. TNDT 80B.
 1. Main Screen.
 2. Swipe down from the Middle.
 3. You should see "Connected as a Media Device."
 4. Tap on "Connected as a Media Device."
 5. Make sure the "Media Device (MTP) is checked."
3. Download and Run the MD5 Checksum Program.
 - a. Go to this link
 - i. <http://www.md5summer.org/download.html>
 - ii. Download "Released 05-04-2006."
 - iii. Unzip it to your Desktop.
 - iv. Double Click on the Icon for MD5 Summer on your desktop.

MD5 (CHECK SUM) PROCEDURES FOR TABLETS

- v. If you get a Pop Up that “MD5 Failed to set file associations”, just click on “OK.”
 - vi. You will get a Pop Up showing a Directory Listing.
 - vii. Find your Drive Letter that shows your Tablet.
 - viii. Double left click on that Drive Letter to open folder.
 - ix. Double left click on .Navi folder.
 - x. Double left click on the NaviMaps folder.
 - xi. Note the NaviMaps folder will highlight, but not open.
 - xii. On the bottom click on “Create Sums.”
 - xiii. On the next screen, click on “Select All.”
 - xiv. Click on “Add.”
 - xv. You should now see all the files populate the right side of the MD5 Window.
 - xvi. Click on “OK.”
 - xvii. The MD 5 should now be creating the Check Sum Hash Tags.
 - xviii. This may take about 5 minutes.
 - xix. Once done you will get another Pop Up.
 - xx. Name the File Name your Last Name for ease of use.
 - xxi. Do not change the location. It will be in the .Navi/NaviMaps folder on your tablet.
 - xxii. Click on “Save.”
 - xxiii. Click on “Close” on the MD5 Generating Pop Up.
 - xxiv. Click on “X” in the upper right to close this window.
 - xxv. Open up your E-Mail program and attach the “MD5” file you just generated on the tablet (.Navi/NaviMaps) folder with your name.
 - xxvi. Send the E-Mail to the given E-Mail address.
4. Press the On/Off button momentarily to wake the Tablet up if the screen “blanked out.”
- a. On the TNDT 70 Tablet.
 - i. Press the lower right “Turn Off USB Storage.”
 - ii. Disconnect from the computer.
 - b. On the “Original” TNDT 80 tablet.
 - i. Press the lower right “Turn Off USB Storage.”
 - ii. Disconnect from the computer.
 - c. On the TNDT 80B just disconnect it from the computer.
